The chosen measure for this is the entitlement of Free School Meals within the past six years. The current funding for Washingwell Community Primary School is £56,470 + £1,994 Covid Recovery Premium = £58,464
Costs have been allocated in the following ways:

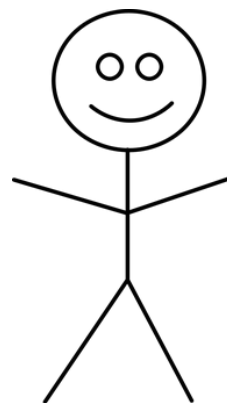
Academic, Enrichment/Engagement, Wellbeing

Interventions

Overview: Provision of Teaching Assistant and Teacher time to deliver specific intervention programmes to support children.

Aim/Outcomes: To accelerate rates of progress in all subjects across all year groups.



Family Support Worker

Overview: To support families through 1:1 work, small group work, targeted outreach work and interagency working.

£29,017.00

Aim/Outcomes: To improve the emotional wellbeing of children to support in motivation and attainment.

Incentive Awards

Overview: To purchase certificates, stickers, prizes, awards and badges in line with incentive schemes.

£1,000.00

Aim/Outcomes: To increase self-esteem and motivation, and to improve attendance.

Subsidised Educational Visits

Overview: School visits (including residential) subsidised to ensure access for all pupils.

Aim/Outcomes: To raise aspirations, motivation and engagement. To improve behaviour.

Attendance

Overview: To purchase A* Attendance online system

Aim/Outcomes: To improve attendance, ensuring full access to all aspects of school life.

Enrichment Activities

Overview: Pupils have the opportunity to experience a wide range of new arts and cultural experiences.

Aim/Outcomes: To increase self-esteem and provide opportunities to children who would otherwise not be able to partake in them.

School Milk

Overview: To provide milk alongside school lunches

£2,500.00

Aim/Outcomes: To ensure all children have a nutritious drink with school meal.
