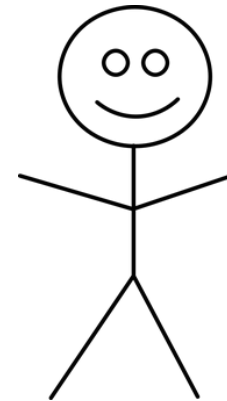


Pupil Premium Provision Mapping 2025-2026

The Pupil Premium is additional monies given to schools to support pupils who are considered disadvantaged. The chosen measure for this is the entitlement of Free School Meals within the past six years. The current funding for Washingwell Community Primary School is £67,695

Academic, Enrichment/Engagement, Wellbeing



Interventions

Overview: Provision of Teaching Assistant and Teacher time to deliver specific intervention programmes to support children.

£24,524

Aim/Outcomes: To accelerate rates of progress in all subjects across all year groups.

Attendance

Overview: To purchase A* Attendance online system
£1,500

Aim/Outcomes: To improve attendance, ensuring full access to all aspects of school life.

Subsidised Educational Visits

Overview: School visits (including residentials) subsidised to ensure access for all pupils.

£1,500

Aim/Outcomes: To raise aspirations, motivation and engagement. To improve behaviour.

Enrichment Activities

Overview: Pupils have the opportunity to experience a wide range of new arts and cultural experiences.

£1000

Aim/Outcomes: To increase self-esteem and provide opportunities to children who would otherwise not be able to partake in them.

Resources & Equipment

Overview: To purchase relevant resources, equipment to support with school focused interventions and learning activities
£4,000

Aim/Outcomes: To increase self-esteem and motivation, and to improve academic achievement.

Health & Wellbeing Service

Overview: To provide opportunities to promote and support health & wellbeing

£670

Aim/Outcomes: To improve the emotional wellbeing, healthy lifestyle and attendance.

School Milk

Overview: To provide milk alongside school lunches

£350

Aim/Outcomes: To ensure all children have a nutritious drink with school meal.

Family Support Worker

Overview: To support families through 1:1 work, small group work, targeted outreach work and interagency working.

£32,651

Aim/Outcomes: To improve the emotional wellbeing of children to support in motivation and attainment.

Incentive Awards

Overview: To purchase certificates, stickers, prizes, awards and badges in line with incentive schemes.

£1,000

Aim/Outcomes: To increase self-esteem and motivation, and to improve attendance.

Washingwell Whizz Kids (before and after school club)

Overview: To provide a nutritional breakfast/tea and social interaction.

£500
