Building confidence to explore new activities and play cooperatively with others.

Learning to take turns, share resources and work together during play.

Becoming more independent with routines and self-care.

Developing friendships and showing kindness and consideration towards others.

Physical Development

Developing coordination and balance through active outdoor games and movement activities.

Strengthening fine motor skills through building, drawing and creative activities.

Exploring movement in different ways, such as fast, slow, high and low.

Using tools like scissors, pencils and paintbrushes with increasing control.

Communication and Language

Talking about different types of transport and sharing their own experiences of journeys.

Listening to stories, songs and instructions linked to transport themes.

Beginning to ask and answer simple questions during play and group discussions.

Using new vocabulary linked to vehicles, travel and movement.
